## Role of an Ordinary Member

- To sit as part of a tribunal panel, to hear appeals (references or claims) against education authorities/responsible bodies in relation to additional support needs or disability discrimination in education.
- To exercise strong teamwork and to constructively challenge and support the convener or leader, as part of a team in a tribunal setting or similar
- To carefully consider arguments, points of consideration and apply knowledge to arrive at balanced judgements.
- To be courteous and considerate to all tribunal users and staff and sensitive to people from different social backgrounds.
- To maintain up to date knowledge of additional support needs law, practice and procedures.

## **Time Commitment**

The time commitment expected is expected to be of the order of 10 days per year, depending on the volume of work of the tribunal.
